

10. All insurance coverages derived from shared policies with any other community or other fund, and all umbrella and excess insurance policies;
11. The current Cash on Hand of Wolverine Village, as of 6/30/2020;
12. Any amounts the Village maintains as reserve(s) for litigation;
13. All pending lawsuits against the Village;
14. All lawsuits to which the Village has been a party over the last ten (10) years;
15. All rezoning petitions to commercial that were granted and denied to any resident or applicant over the last ten (10) years;
16. The conflict of interest, self-dealing and ethical conduct rules governing elected and appointed officials of the Village;
17. Minimum credentials and/or requirements for any person to serve as council member or equivalent fiduciary capacity.


