Minutes: Special meeting June 15, 2020

Call to Order: Meeting was called to order by President Ochs at 7:00 p.m.

Agenda: Ochs explained the purpose of the meeting was to review and discuss the rezoning decisions made by the Planning Commission on June 10, 2020, and specifically the rezoning of parcel 242-012-200-007-11, where the Commission failed to reach a majority vote on the request of Robert E. Ford to rezone the parcel Commercial, and the appeal of the Commission's decision filed by the Dollar General organization on behalf of Robert E. Ford.

Following much discussion, and after giving each guest an opportunity to speak, D. Holden offered a motion, with support from K. Holden to accept the decision of the Planning Commission on the Village's request to rezone parcel 242-012-200-007-12 Commercial. Motion carried, with Ford abstaining due to conflict of interest.

Motion by D. Holden with support from K. Holden to table until the Village's July 13th regular meeting, the request of Robert E. Ford to rezone parcel 242-012-200-007-11 Commercial and Dollar General's appeal request. Motion made in an effort to give Council more time to research and address the concerns expressed by those present. Motion carried with Ford abstaining due to conflict of interest.
